- In order to determine if your new swimmer is swim team ready, we will be hosting a casual swim "try-out" event (Date & Place: To be Announced). The goal is to provide a comfortable venue for new swimmers to demonstrate their ability to swim the length of the pool and other swim team readiness skills.
- If you are 11 and older, you may contact the swim team to request a waiver from the "try-out" requirement. All children 10 and under who are new swimmers are required to attend the "try-out".
- New team applicants will be contacted and notified of available team positions. **Registration fee, AAU Card, and Concussion Form** will be due for selected new members. Practice Pod to be determined.
- Fee is \$120 for first child and \$100 for each additional.

Returning Swim Team Members

Prospective Swim Team Members (New Applicants)

- Youth between the ages of 6 and 18 who can swim a 25 yard freestyle in good form may try out for the team. Swimming 25 yards does not guarantee placement on the team. Swimmers may be given the recommendation to take swim lessons. Swim team is NOT swim lessons!

- If your child has trouble swimming or managing themselves we ask for parents to stay at pool and keep an eye on them until a coach feels they can manage.
