Returning Swim Team Members

Due to limited slots, swimmers who participated in the 2022 swim season will be given the opportunity to rejoin the team by completing their registration on time.

- Swim team members must arrive on time for practice sessions.
- Swimmers must follow the instructions of the coach and team officials.
- Swimmers must comply with all facility/pool and competition rules and regulations, and observe safety guidelines at all times. Team Handbook & League By-Laws can be found at www.mvkillerwhales.org under Registration & Info.

Prospective Swim Team Members (New Applicants)

- Youth between the ages of 6 and 18 who can swim a 25 yard freestyle in good form may try out for the team. Swimming 25 yards does not guarantee placement on the team. Swimmers may be given the recommendation to take swim lessons. Swim team is NOT swim lessons!
 - Twisp pool has swim lessons and can be reached at www.townoftwisp.com
- If your child has trouble swimming or managing themselves we ask for parents to stay at the pool and keep an eye on them until a coach feels they can manage.
- Tryouts will be held in May for new swimmers, stay tuned for more information regarding tryouts after registration is over.
- All Swim Teams members are expected to attend and participate in 4 swim meets each season and championships!

Parents

- Parents are actively involved in running all aspects of the dual meets and our invitational meet. Parents are expected to assist in 3 home meets, and your support is greatly appreciated. Look for signs at the pool and/or emails to volunteer.
- Please note that practice groups will also be set based on ability, not just age. During the first few weeks of practice, the coaches will make adjustments to practice groups (pods) if need be.
